

Subject: Resolutions for a United Ireland Introduced into PA Legislature - Please call your State Rep & Senator

Recently resolutions were introduced into the PA State Senate by Senator Mike Stack of Philadelphia and into the Lower House by Tim Hennessey of Chester County expressing the desire for a United Ireland. There have been several legislators willing to support the bill to date – including my own representative Nick Kotik of Carnegie PA, Chelsa Wagner of Pittsburgh and several more.

Please contact your own State Senator and Representative and ask them to support these resolutions so that Pennsylvania may be counted as one of the states who have passed resolutions for a United Ireland. To date, Massachusetts and New Jersey have already passed similar bills. Several cities and municipalities in PA have also passed resolutions including Philadelphia and Pittsburgh and Allegheny County.
